## FAQ's:

For all our applicants, there is a mandatory 14 day trial period to ensure a smooth transition to our program.

Due to the high-risk nature inherent in working with horses, applicants under the age of 18 are welcome to apply but will be accepted on an individual basis.

US residents will be given preference over international applicants (insurance policy stipulations).

General barn schedule – 7AM- 5PM with a lunch break.

The schedule does not impede the acquisition of an offsite part time job and will include 1 full day off per week (typically a Monday).

Approved SEI/ASTM helmets are mandatory for all riding. No exceptions.

Protective vests are strongly recommended for jumping and required for cross country schooling.

No mucking at the farm. Overnight competitions will necessitate the use of a pitchfork.

Any outside horses will need to be on the same de-worming and vaccination program.

Final interview will be conducted in person here at Watermark Farm. Mounted. There is a non-disclosure agreement.
